

This decision was publically communicated in December 2015 as part of the site designations summary table as follows:

The Province's 2013 Parks and Protected Areas Plan stipulates that designation of parts of Tracadie River Wilderness Area is subject to wood supply analysis. This analysis, since completed, was undertaken to ensure that protecting these lands would not adversely affect existing Provincial wood supply commitments. As a result, final boundaries for the wilderness area differ somewhat from those in the Parks and Protected Areas Plan, with a slightly reduced area. To make up for additional wood volume protected within Tracadie River Wilderness Area, certain other lands identified in the 2013 Plan for potential protection, subject to wood supply analysis, will not be protected. These will contribute to Crown wood supply rather than protection.

The Interim Management Policies and Procedures for Crown lands included in the August 2013 Parks and Protected Areas Plan (November 2014) has been applied to these lands to help ensure that they were managed in a manner consistent with their intended protection objectives. As they are no longer being considered for protection, the Interim Management Policies and Procedures should no longer apply to these lands, and they should be made available for general Crown land use.

It is my understanding that staff of both Departments have already reviewed these sites, and are working to update public and internal mapping to ensure accurate depiction of these changes.

### Dear Chief Googoo:

I am writing in continued consultation under the August 31, 2010 Mi'kmaq-Nova Scotia-Canada Consultation Terms of Reference regarding the 12% protected lands initiative.

On June 12, 2015 the Mi'kmaq-Nova Scotia Protected Areas Selection and Management Technical Advisory Group ("Advisory Group") discussed possible changes to the designation of certain sites identified in the 2013 Parks and Protected Areas Plan. Most of these changes were minor – arising from more detailed boundary survey and field work. However, larger changes are being considered for some areas based on subsequent review or updated government direction.

Of the twenty five areas discussed, the Advisory Group identified nine for which additional consultation is desired. This letter pertains to the following six areas (shapefiles also attached).

Parks and Protected Area Plan Site	Type of Change being considered	
Aylesford Mountain Nature Reserve	Boundary revision - add 45 ha of adjacent Crown land to Nature Reserve.	
2. Lower Mersey Nature Reserve	Designation - portions of the pending nature reserve bordering a narrow band of riverside land identified as Mersey River Provincial Park may be added to park; and portions of the park may be added to the nature reserve.	
3. Medway Lakes Wilderness Area	Designation - area proposed as Fisher Lake Provincial Park (120 ha) would become part of Medway Lakes Wilderness Area; minor boundary adjustments to improve management and protection; possible changes to boundary associated with access and use of former Bowater roads in area.	
4. Shingle Lake, Pleasant River Nature Reserves	Designation – possibility to combine these two nature reserve sites into Pleasant River Wilderness Area. Future consideration would be given to creating a no-trapping regulation to protect key species and ecological processes. There are also some minor boundary changes associated with legal review of lands.	
5. West St. Andrews	Designation - The designation type for these lands was identified in the plan as being "subject to additional planning and consultation". Ecological criteria support Nature Reserve	

designation, but this would limit hunting, trapping, and resource gathering activities.

6. St. Andrews River Wilderness Area

Boundary – lands identified in the 2013 plan are linked to the outcome of trade discussions with private land owner. This area is also associated with Environmental Assessment review for the future Alton Gas pipeline, and is linked to the consultation on that project.

In addition, for the three remaining areas, consultation has or will be initiated by DNR in relation to associated Crown land transactions. These sites are:

- Bennery Lake Nature Reserve, Pockwock Wilderness Area, Waverley-Salmon River Long Lake Wilderness
  Area expansion, & Little Soldier Lake Nature Reserve (see January 1 March 31 2015 Quarterly Notification)
- Blue Mountain-Birch Cove Lakes Wilderness Area & Sackville River Nature Reserve (See Consultation Barrett Lumber Land Exchange & Right of Way, initiated on July 22, 2015);
- Guysborough Headlands Wilderness Area (See Consultation on Proposed LNG Terminal at Port Bickerton, Guysborough, initiated on august 22, 2014).

We are working now to move sites from the Parks and Protected Areas Plan forward for legal designation by government, and would like to advance our discussions on the first five sites shown above as soon as possible to facilitate additional planning and decision making. For this reason, a response to this letter by September 14, 2015 would be appreciated. I am also hoping that we will be able to schedule an Advisory Group meeting prior to the end of August so that we can share additional details on these sites, and identify appropriate next steps.


- 6 (1) The Governor in Council may set aside and reserve Crown land as park reserve for the purpose of protecting those lands that have the potential to be a provincial park.
- (2) The Minister may develop programs and policies deemed necessary to control and develop a park reserve.
- (3) No person shall grant or transfer any Crown land constituted as a park reserve unless permitted by the regulations or authorized by the Minister.


#### **Ecological and Recreation Values**

- Predominantly rugged coastal barrens with wetlands. The bedrock-ridged topography is very prominent.

- The property has for many decades been assigned to DNR's parks program as part of the Province's commitment to develop the Eastern Shore Seaside Park System (this initiative followed the withdrawal of a federal proposal to establish a national park on the Eastern Shore in the 1970s).
- The property is referred to by DNR as an "existing park" in the 2013 Parks and Protected Areas Plan (p.54), though it has yet to be legally designated. The interactive map which accompanied the P&PA Plan indicates the status as "pending designation".
- Because of this property's history and status with DNR, it was not included within lands that were designated as Eastern Shore Islands Wilderness Area in 2015.
- The property is within the Nova Scotia Nature Trust's "100 Wild Islands" campaign area. When
  NSNT reports on progress in protecting lands within this area, it includes provincial parks and
  protected areas, including the Owls Head PP property. It has been considered by NSNT to have the
  same status as nearby Clam Harbour Beach and Taylor Head provincial parks, as well as Eastern
  Shore Islands Wilderness Area.
- NSNT is working to secure protection of several adjacent private land coastal parcels and has
  protected several nearby islands.
- The Owls Head PP property is within the geographic area of interest to the Wild Islands Tourism
  Advancement Partnership (WITAP) project, which has as its mission "To position and advance
  Musquodoboit Harbour-Sherbrooke as a dynamic new in-demand destination offering the bestdesigned touring, outdoor & nature infrastructure and experiences in Nova Scotia".






The property consists of a 17.18 hectares of undeveloped coastal lands shown as Parcel 2017-1 on attached Plan S-6096. Property information can be found on the Directory of Federal Real Property (DFRP) property number 03083. The site would surround an active light, shown as Parcel 2017-2, and would be burdened by a clearing easement, shown as 2017-E, to facilitate helicopter access to service the light. The property is adjacent to an existing provincial park.

PSPC provides real property services to many federal government departments and crown agencies, in accordance with various federal acts, policies, directives and regulations. I am the Real Estate Advisor representing PSPC for this disposal.
